All Souls Day

This is when, as believers, with the whole church, we commemorate those who have died and are now in Purgatory – the state of being cleansed of venial sins and temporal punishment due for the mortal sins that they had con-

In this Jubilee Year it is possible to gain a double plenary indulgence each day from November 1-8, but only if you can obtain one for yourself and another for the souls in purgatory. One plenary indulgence — remission of all temporal punishment due to sin — per day is a great gift of the Church, but two in one day is a rare exception. The second indulgence can be obtained by performing an act of charity on behalf of the deceased and receiving Holy Communion a second time on the same day.

You must also meet the usual requirements for any indulgence, including confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer for the Holy Father's intentions for each indulgence.

The Jubilee of Hope 2025

The Holy Year which began with the opening of the door by Pope Francis on Christmas Eve last will conclude on the 6th of January. For the 2025 Jubilee year, each Irish diocese has designated local Jubilee churches, and three national pilgrimage sites have also been chosen - Lough Derg, Knock Shrine, Croagh Patrick



Examples of Other Jubilee churches include: St. Eugene's Cathedral, Derry, St. Eunan's Cathedral, Letterkenny, Ards Capuchin Friary, Rossnowlagh Franciscan Friary, Séipéal Mhuire, Na Doirí Beaga, St. Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh

The first step in obtaining the Jubilee indulgence is a desire for repentance and conversion. We undertake to detach our lives from sin – even venial sins.

Secondly as 'pilgrims of hope' during the Holy Year, we undertake to receive devoutly the Sacrament of Confession and Holy Communion, and to pray for the Pope's intention in one of the following ways:

By pilgrimage or visit to any sacred Jubilee site including those mentioned above. Engaging in Eucharistic adoration, meditation and prayer, concluding with the Our Father, the Profession of Faith and invocations to Mary, the Mother of God.

By works of mercy and penance, for example, visiting someone in need or in difficulty; dedicate Friday fasting or abstinence; support the defence and protection of life in all its phases; volunteering in the community; making a charitable donation to the poor; participating in popular missions, spiritual exercises, or formation activities held in a church or other suitable places.

The Jubilee Prayer

Father in heaven, may the faith you have given us in your son, Jesus Christ, our brother, and the flame of charity enkindled in our hearts by the Holy Spirit, reawaken in us the blessed hope for the coming of your Kingdom.

May your grace transform us into tireless cultivators of the seeds of the Gospel. May those seeds transform from within both humanity and the whole cosmos in the sure expectation of a new heaven and a new earth, when, with the powers of Evil vanquished, your glory will shine eternally.

> May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, Pilgrims of Hope, a yearning for the treasures of heaven. May that same grace spread the joy and peace of our Redeemer throughout the earth. To you our God, eternally blessed, be glory and praise for ever. Amen
