WOKEISM — THE END OF THE CHARADE



The organisers of the opening ceremony at the Olympic games felt it important to include a gross mockery of the Last Supper. They felt the need to ridicule this central moment in Christian faith, where Jesus gives his body and blood in anticipation of the cross. They felt the need to openly mock what Christians hold as sacred. And they do this, they say, in the interest of 'being inclusive'.

The perpetrators of this desecration are the anti-Truth advocates of Woke ideology. There has, of course, been an outcry in response to this mockery among Christians, and non-Christians.



Reacting to what he called this 'demonic' sacrilege of the Last Supper, world renowned Catholic commentator (and founder of the global *Word on Fire* ministry), Bishop Robert Barron has commented that the self-obsessed Woke promoters have made it clear who their enemy is, and who they are afraid of:

"Their enemy is the Catholic Church. Their enemy is the Mass. Their enemy is Jesus Christ."

This is Wokeism, he says. It is deeply secularist. They advocate for the eradication of what is True ... and the Catholic Faith stands in their way. Helpfully, the farce at the Olympic games ended the pretence that they are about anything else. Their propaganda is out in the open, and they are telling us that Christian Faith is its enemy.

Well, they got that right. That is true!
