

We either know who Frankie Byrne is ... or we don't. If we do know her it probably says something about our age! Frankie is described as "Ireland's first agony aunt". How might she advise us about the problem Jesus points out to us today?

Here's Pope Benedict speaking about it

... 'second death' that is:

"True death *[unlike mortal death]* is to be feared. It is the death of the soul which the BOOK OF REVELATION calls **"the second death"**. In fact, those who die in mortal sin without repentance, locked into their proud rejection of God's love, exclude themselves from the Kingdom of life."

He's talking about this from the Book of Revelation (21:8):

"The cowardly, the unbelieving, the vile, the murderers, the sexually immoral, those who practice magic arts, the idolaters and all liars – their place will be in the fiery lake of burning sulfur. This is the **second death**."



And there's more (Book of Revelation 20:6)

Blessed and holy are those who share in the first resurrection; over such the **second death** has no power.

Which means, our Church teaches, that the **second death** is exclusively for those who have rejected Christ. It is not a place believers in Christ should fear.

So, it may not be our problem today. Frankie (and Jesus) are saying *"Make sure it doesn't become your problem!"*
