



TAP 'N GO HAS ARRIVED IN CLONMANY PARISH



he Derry diocese have asked Clonmany parish to be part of pilot scheme for the roll -out of the *Tap 'n Go* payment option across the Diocese. You may have noticed the machine at the main door in Saint Mary's.

The idea may seem new to us, but it is normal practice in most dioceses these days — and, for many of us, normal practice in everyday life.

• WHERE DO ANY DONATIONS GO?

Every cent donated at our *tap 'n go* stays in our parish. It is for the everyday upkeep of the parish. It helps pay for our everyday running costs — electric, phone, heating, insurance, lighting, stationary, Mass leaflets, and the like. Any donations are (as always) greatly appreciated.

Apart from the everyday use by parishioners, experience (in other parishes) has shown that the *tap 'n go* option is also used by visitors to parish events.

Other parishes in Inishowen, such as Carndonagh and Iskaheen, have already installed this payment option. Our Clonmany option, however, is different in that it is the model being piloted by the diocese, and the only one in Donegal.

Hopefully it will prove to be a beneficial addition to our parish going forward (and the diocese will be impressed by our efforts)!
