Lourdes is one of the most sacred places in Christian faith — and to go there as a pilgrim is not to go as a bystander, looking on.

As life goes by, we realise more deeply our need of GOD (of course, some are given this grace early in life). And whether we have been actively looking, or it has come upon us because of illness or circumstance, to know our need for GOD is a blessing.

One of GOD's answers to this need is the opportunity of a pilgrimage to Lourdes. It is a place of Encounter. The apparition of Our Lady to Saint Bernadette at Lourdes, the courage and holiness of Bernadette herself, the atmosphere of prayer and peace at the grotto, the healing in soul and body, the journeying with fellow seekers and sinners, the laughter and tears and hope — all have been a wonderful testimony to the response of GOD to the need of countless thousands of people in our time.

To come to Lourdes is to come with the good things in our lives: our family, food, health, gifts, joys, successes. It is to come with what is difficult in our lives: personal struggle, difficulties in our homes (with those we love), our burdens and disappointments.

There are as many reasons to come to Lourdes as there are people who go to Lourdes. Often, experience tells us, the reason people *think* they come is not the reason the LORD had in mind. Perhaps it has to be enough to respond to the words of Our Lady to Saint Bernadette: "Tell the people to come."
