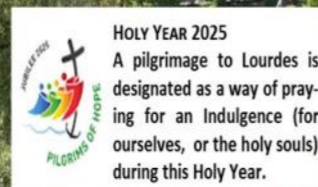

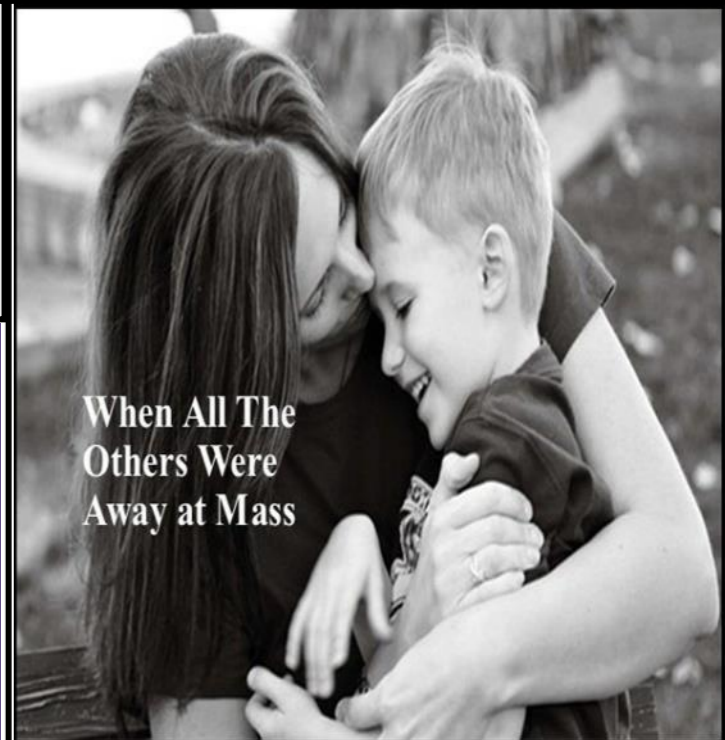
SPARK: A weekend of fun, faith and friendship for 12-16 year olds

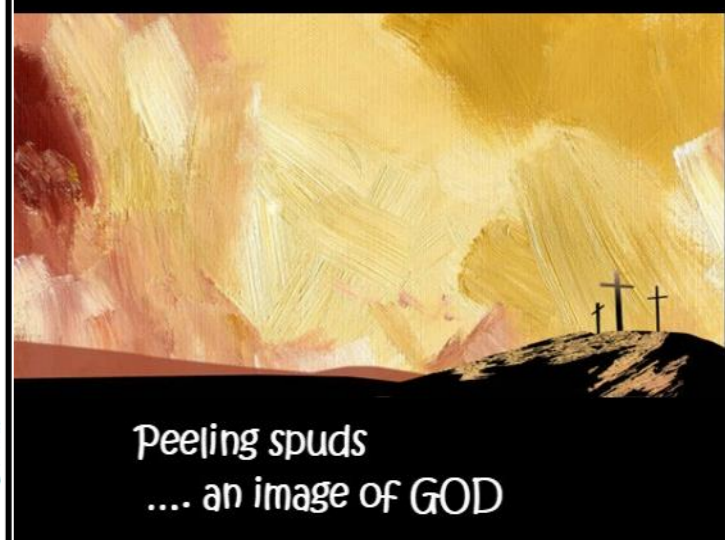


**When All The
