The canonisation of Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati September 7th. Two young Italians – united in their love of Christ Pier Giorgio Frassati died in 1925 as a result of contracting polio. He was only 24 years old. A keen mountaineer, he spent much of his time looking after the poor, the homeless and the sick. 'To the heights' of holiness is a motto for Catholics inspired by Frassati to strive for the summit of eternal life with Christ. Carlo Acutis died in 2006 shortly after being diagnosed with leukaemia. He was 15 years old. Known for his great devotion to the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist he will become the first millennial to be declared a saint by the Catholic Church. He used his deep faith and digital savvy to draw attention to Eucharistic miracles around the world. The Eucharist was his 'highway to Heaven'.
