

CLONMANY PARISH CEMETERIES

Clonmany parish, in collaboration with the Clonmany Genealogy & Heritage Group, is in the process of establishing a graves index of the three graveyards in the parish. The surveys of the graveyards at St. Mary's Church, at the New Graveyard in Cleagh and at St. Michael's Church, Urris, are being carried out by professional surveyors from Co. Mayo. When completed, detailed graves maps will be erected at each of the three locations, and an online database will be available, free of charge, for everyone to access, including locals, ex-parishioners living abroad, researchers and genealogists. In the coming days, draft maps of the graveyards will be displayed in St. Mary's Church, Clonmany and in St. Michael's Church, Urris. Parishioners are asked to review the maps and note any errors on the Correction Sheets provided, and the corrections forwarded to the address on the sheets. Draft online maps of the graveyards are also available to view on the Irish Graveyard Surveyors website.
