
#### PRE-SYNODAL ASSEMBLY - 18 OCTOBER 2025

#### PRISONS WEEK 12-19<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2025

Prisons Week raises awareness and generates prayer. It motivates volunteers to step forward and give their time and gifts in prisons and in their own communities. It provides an annual focus and reason for Christians to work together, building capacity and motivation to make a difference for people who are out of sight and often out of mind.

#### MESSAGE OF HOPE

2025 has been declared the Jubilee Year of Hope with its message of 'Hope does not disappoint' Jubilee Years occur every 25 years. As part of this Jubilee Year the Pope visited Rebebbia prison in Rome and open for the first time a Holy Door at a prison. The opening of Holy Doors is part of the Jubilee Year celebrations going back over centuries and the open of a Holy Door in a prison was a gesture by the Pope to invite people in prison wherever they are to be part of the Jubilee of Hope. As part of this year Pope Francis designated 14<sup>th</sup> December this year as the Jubilee of Prisoners. While Pope Francis will not be there to celebrate this day, it is hoped that Pope Leo will continue his message of hope and his dedication to the rights and dignity of people in prison.

#### **Comfort Prayer**

Heavenly Father life in prison is very hard, especially for those who have gone there for the very first time. Lord, please comfort them, and give them strength to face one day at a time. See them through these tough times and let them come to know you as the God that comforts them. Lord, even though they have sinned against you I know that you have forgiven them and you're going to turn their lives around if only then can believe in you. Instead of looking for comfort in other things, please help them to turn to you. Remind them of how much you love them in Jesus name, I believe and pray.
