"You are my hope" (Ps 71:5)

This Sunday we celebrate the "9th World Day of the Poor". Pope Leo in his message reminds communities that the poor are at the heart of all our pastoral activity and that it is our responsibility in this Jubilee Year to 'encourage the development of policies aimed at combatting forms of poverty both old and new, as well as implementing new initiatives to support and assist the poorest of the poor.'

For us all, the realisation that God is our first and only hope enables us to 'pass from fleeting hopes to a lasting hope. Once we desire that God accompany us on the journey of life, material wealth becomes relativized, for we discover the real treasure that we need.'

He goes on to say that the 'gravest form of poverty is not to know God.' Therefore, the worst discrimination which the poor suffer is the lack of spiritual care. Since they need God we must be ready to offer them his friendship, his blessing, his word, the celebration of the sacraments and a journey of growth and maturity in the faith.
